

How to set up a MyDonate page

Setting up a MyDonate page is the best place to get started if you are taking part in a challenge or event to collect sponsorship. The following steps will guide you through setting up your own MyDonate page:

- 1.) Login to personal account by clicking the login button near the top right of the page. If you do not have a personal account, you can register one at www.bt.com/mydonate.
- 2.) Once you are logged in please select 'Start fundraising' from the navigation tab on the top of the page.
- 3.) Either select 'Join an organised event' if you are participating in one of our events, or click 'Create my challenge' if you are taking part in your own challenge for us.

- 5.) Add the details about your event, including the dates, location, and whether your fundraising activity is eligible for Gift Aid.
- 6.) **Important note about Gift Aid:** If you are organising an event which involves the sale of tickets, an auction, a raffle or an event where participants pay to receive a prize, please do not click to allow Gift Aid when setting up your fundraising page. LandAid can't claim Gift Aid on these donations.
